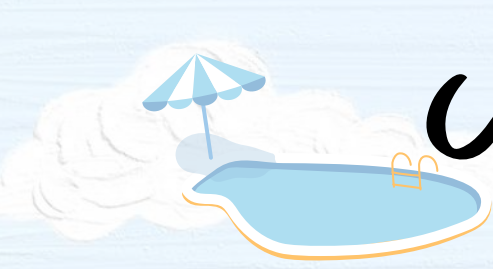

Compliance Corner

With the arrival of spring, routine compliance inspections will soon begin throughout the community. Residents are encouraged to review their property and ensure they follow the guidelines. We will start out looking at compliance with the following:

***Decorative objects-Items are to be located in rear yard locations and should not be visible from the front yard. Approval is required for all exterior decorative objects, whether natural or man-made, which are not a part of the original construction design. Exterior decorative objects are permitted in rear yards only. Examples include but are not limited to bird houses, bird baths, boulders, large decorative rocks, driftwood, weathervanes, sculptures, statues, plaques, fountains, free standing poles of any type (including garden flags), and any other ornament or object. Ensure sure seasonal décor is appropriate for the current season.**

***Ensuring that required DRC approvals have been obtained for exterior modifications and that the modification meet the guidelines.**
