Community Parking Reminder

Please be considerate of your neighbors and utilize your garage and driveway parking whenever possible to help preserve visitor parking throughout the community.

Resident vehicles parked on community streets or common area parking spaces should be moved regularly and may not remain parked in the same location for more than 72 hours, in accordance with Community Code #5.

Application Deadline: Noon on the second Thursday of each month

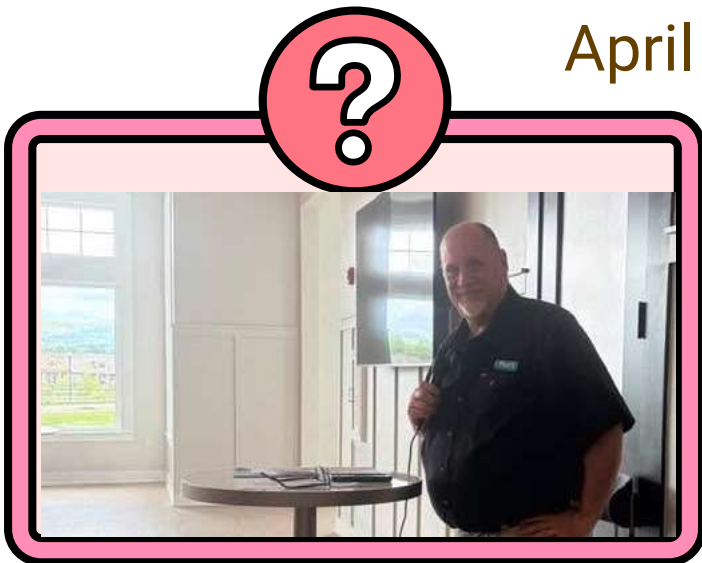
